AN ACT TO TRANSFER SUBDIVISION-DEFAULT FUNDS TO MUNICIPAL PLANNING BOARDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING AN APPROVED SUBDIVISION PLAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 81U of Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end of the penultimate paragraph  
3 the following: — “The proceeds of any such bond or deposit  
4 shall be made immediately available to the planning board for  
5 expenditure to meet the cost and expenses of the municipality  
6 in completing the work as specified in the approved plan. The  
7 provisions of section 53 of chapter forty-four shall not apply.”
