## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-four.

### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO NILMA BRISSENDEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-  
2 trary, the Town of Weymouth is hereby authorized to appro-  
3 priate money for the payment of, and, after such appropria-  
4 tion, the Treasurer of said Town is hereby authorized to pay  
5 to Nilma Brissenden the sum of six hundred seventy-eight dol-  
6 lars and fifty cents for services performed by her in prior fiscal  
7 years as Executive Secretary to the Board of Assessors in said  
8 Town, or take any other action in relation thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
