
By Mr. Webber, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1939) of Peter C. Webber (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize the city of Pittsfield to grant an additional twenty-foot easement to Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, a division of Tenneco, Inc. Local Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL TWENTY FOOT EASEMENT TO TENNESSEE GAS PIPELINE COMPANY, A DIVISION OF TENNECO, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Pittsfield, acting for and on behalf of the Com-
2 monwealth, is hereby authorized to grant to Tennessee Gas
3 Pipeline Company a permanent eastment for an additional
4 twenty foot wide strip adjacent to and in addition to the exist-
5 ing easement of Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company across cer-
6 tain land under the control of the city of Pittsfield. This cer-
7 tain parcel of land is situated in the county of Berkshire and
8 is described in a Plan of Land entitled "Tennessee Gas Pipe-
9 line Company, Proposed Right-of-Way Crossing, the City of
10 Pittsfield Prop. Berkshire County, Massachusetts, TA-L12-
11 E2565C-100-1 on file with the city of Pittsfield.

12 The easement shall be used for the installation of a gas
13 transmission line together with appliances and appurtenances
14 necessary thereto.

15 Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company in payment for said addi-
16 tional easement shall transfer to the city of Pittsfield in fee a
17 parcel of land equivalent to or in excess of the areas of the
18 easement granted or it shall pay a fair value as the city shall
19 determine.
