By Mr. Wetmore, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1951) of Robert D. Wetmore (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Palmer to issue to J. F. Inc., d/b/a One Stop a liquor license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises. Government Regulations.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PALMER TO ISSUE TO J. F. INC., D/B/A ONE STOP A LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of Chap-
2 ter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the li-
3 censing authority of the Town of Palmer is hereby authorized
4 to issue to J. F. Inc., D/B/A One Stop, a license for the sale
5 of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises un-
6 der the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hun-
7 dred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all the
8 provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except
9 section seventeen; and further, that the number of seasonal li-
10 censes for sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on
11 the premises in the Town of Palmer under the provisions of
12 said section seventeen shall be reduced by one such license.
