AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF MEMBERS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law
- 2 to the contrary, there shall be made available to members of
- 3 the Senate and the House of Representatives of both genders,
- 4 in the immediate vicinity of the Senate & House Chambers,
- 5 bathroom and shower facilities of equal accommodations.
