The committee on Ways and Means, to whom was committed the House Bill making appropriations for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four to provide for supplementing certain existing appropriations and for certain new activities and projects (House, No. 5623), reports recommending that the same ought to pass, with an amendment, striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the text of Senate document numbered 2022.

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in
 2 the general appropriation act and for certain new activities
 3 and projects the sums set forth in section two for the several
 4 purposes and subject to the provisions of law regulating the
 5 disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to
 6 appropriations in chapter two hundred and eighty-nine of the
 7 acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-four or for such period as
 8 may be specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition
 9 to any amounts available for the purpose.

 21 ed, further, that said commissioner shall file with
 22 the house and senate committees on ways and
 23 means a quarterly report of itemized expenditures
 24 of all funds appropriated herein; provided, further,
 25 that no funds appropriated herein shall be used for
 26 the maintenance and administration of the depart-
