### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF HANDICAPPED AFFAIRS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 185 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as inserted by  
2 section 289 of Chapter 351 of the acts of 1981, is hereby amend-  
3 ed by striking out the fourth sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following:

5 The position of director shall be classified in accordance with  
6 section forty-five of chapter thirty, and the salary shall be  
7 determined in accordance with section forty-six C of said  
8 chapter thirty, provided, however that such position initially  
9 shall be allocated to job group M-VIII under said section forty-  
10 six C. The director shall devote his full time during business  
11 hours to the duties of the office.
