AN ACT TO TRANSFER SUBDIVISION-DEFAULT FUNDS TO MUNICIPAL PLANNING BOARDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING AN APPROVED SUBDIVISION PLAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 81U of Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph after the 9th para-  
3 graph: —

4 “Upon acceptance by a city or town of this paragraph, the  
5 provisions of Section 53 of Chapter 44 shall not apply, and the  
6 proceeds of any such bond or default shall be made immedi-  
7 ately available to the planning board for the expenditure to  
8 meet the cost and expenses of the municipality in completing  
9 the work as specified in the approval plan.”
