RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT RELATIVE TO FLOODING IN THE CITY OF PEABODY.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of environmental manage-
2 ment, through its division of waterways, is hereby authorized
3 and directed to make an investigation and study relative to the
4 flooding of the Peabody Square district of the city of Peabody,
5 including the Foster street and Walnut street areas of said
6 city. Said department shall report to the general court the
7 results of its investigation and study and its recommendations,
8 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
9 said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with
10 the clerk of the senate on or before the last Wednesday in
11 December, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
