AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING AUTHORITY OF FALMOUTH TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO PARRISH, INC., D/B/A WEST FALMOUTH MARKET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven-
2 teen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General
3 Laws, the licensing authority of the Town of Falmouth is
4 hereby authorized to issue a license under section fifteen of
5 said chapter one hundred thirty-eight for the annual sale of
6 all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises to Par-
7 rish Inc., d/b/a West Falmouth Market, which license shall
8 be subject to and have the benefit of said chapter one hundred
9 thirty-eight, excepting the provisions of said section seven-
10 teen; provided, however, that the number of seasonal licenses
11 for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the
12 premises authorized for said town to issue under the provisions
13 of said section seventeen shall be reduced by one license.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passge.
