Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 10K the following section:—
- 3 Section 10K½. The Commissioner may at the request of the
- 4 Massachusetts Criminal Justice Training Council appoint as
- 5 special police officers such employees of said council as may
- 6 be designated by the council's executive director. Such special
- 7 police officers shall serve for one year, subject to removal by
- 8 the Commissioner and shall have the power to transport illegal
- 9 drugs. They shall report to the Commissioner as to their official
- 10 acts at such time and in such manner as he may require. They
- 11 shall serve without pay, except their regular compensation as
- 12 employees of said council.
