The committee on Ways and Means, to whom was committed the Senate Bill authorizing the Metropolitan District Commission to grant a certain easement in the town of Hardwick to the W. R. Robinson lumber company (Senate, No. 733), reports recommending that the same ought to pass, with an amendment, substituting a new draft entitled "An Act directing the Metropolitan District Commission to grant a permit to the W. R. Robinson Lumber Company, Inc., for use of certain land" (Senate, No. 2299).

AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO GRANT A PERMIT TO THE W.R. ROBINSON LUMBER COMPANY FOR USE OF CERTAIN LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Metropolitan District Commission is hereby directed to
2 grant a permit to the W.R. Robinson Lumber Company, Inc.,
3 in the town of Barre to use a certain parcel of land located in
4 the town of Hardwick, for entrance and egress purposes to cer-
5 tain other land. Said permit shall be granted subject to the pro-
6 visions of sections forty E through forty J of the General Laws
7 and for such consideration and in accordance with such terms
8 as the Metropolitan District Commission may prescribe. Said
9 permit shall be granted for the use of two acres more or less,
10 bounded and described as follows: —

11 *BEGINNING:* At a Worcester County Highway bound at Sta.
12 46 + 38.80 in the Easterly line of Petersham Road;

13 *THENCE:* No. $63^{\circ} 18' E.$, 431.11 feet to an M.D.C. bound in
14 a corner of stone walls;

15 *THENCE:* S. $59^{\circ} 33' 09'' E.$, 437.63 feet to an M.D.C. bound
16 in a corner of stone walls at land now of W.R. Robinson
17 Lumber Co., Inc.;

18 *THENCE:* N. $32^{\circ} 39' 40'' E.$ along a stone wall and land of
19 W.R. Robinson Lumber Co., Inc. 50.03 feet to a point;

20 *THENCE:* No. $59^{\circ} 33' 09'' W.$, 467.0 feet to a point;

21 *THENCE:* S. $63^{\circ} 18'' W.$, 458 feet more or less to a point in
22 the Easterly line of Petersham Road;

23 *THENCE:* Southerly following the Easterly line of Petersham
24 Road 50 feet to the point of beginning.
