AN ACT FOR LEGISLATION RELATIVE TO THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other provisions of Chapter 572 of the
2 Acts of 1985, Section 49 of Chapter 152, as most recently amended
3 by Section 6 of Chapter 314 of the Acts of 1953, shall apply to
4 all injuries occurring prior to the effective date of Section 53
5 Chapter 572 of the Acts of 1985.
