AN ACT CREATING AN ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH EXTENSION SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 the following section: —
- 3 Section 38. The trustees are hereby authorized and directed to
- 4 establish and maintain within the division of public health on the
- 5 university campus in the town of Amherst, an environmental
- 6 health extension service. Said service shall be for the purpose of
- 7 studying environmental health issues including but not limited to
- 8 providing educational consultative and research resources to
- 9 various state departments, local health officers, board of public
- 10 health, hazardous waste officers, legal system, and the media.
