### AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR PLUMBERS AND GAS FITTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 142, Section 6 is amended by striking the third sentence
- 2 and substituting the following:
- 3 "Licenses shall be issued for two years and may be renewed
- 4 every two years on or before the first of May, or in case of absence,
- 5 sickness or other disability of the holder, on or before such later
- 6 date as the examiners may permit, upon payment of the required
- 7 fee and presentation of proof of fulfillment of continuing
- 8 education requirements as specified by the examiners."
