AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 69 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 287 of the Statutes of 1973, is hereby
- 3 repealed and in place thereof is substituted the following section:
- 4 Section 69. Sale to intoxicated persons.
- 5 No alcoholic beverage shall be sold or delivered on any premises
- 6 licensed under this chapter to an intoxicated person.
