AN ACT TO ASSIGN ONE PERCENT (1%) OF THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE  
LOTTERY FUND TO THE STATE ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The funds necessary to maintain and expand the Title III C 1
- 2 and Title III C 2 Nutrition Program are no longer available from
- 3 the Federal Government.
- 4 Increased cost due to inflation and increased demand for
- 5 additional meals makes it necessary to seek new funding resources
- 6 in order to maintain an adequate level of service for Elderly
- 7 Nutrition Program in Massachusetts.
- 8 Be it enacted that one percent (1%) of Massachusetts Lottery
- 9 by added to the state allotment for elderly meals and that the funds
- 10 be distributed according to formula used for the distribution of
- 11 Title III C 1 and Title III C 2 Federal Funds.
