AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO SELL
ADVERTISING SPACE AT HOCKEY RINKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 after section 102 the following section: —
- 3 Section 103. The commission may, for the purpose of reducing
- 4 the operating expenses of maintaining ice skating rinks, sell
- 5 advertising space at said rinks.
