AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEXUALLY DANGEROUS PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 9 of chapter 123 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 section 1 of chapter 752 of the acts of 1985, is hereby amended  
3 by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following sentence: — Upon such discharge, notice shall be given  
5 to the center, the district attorney in the district from which the  
6 commitment originated, the district attorney in the district where  
7 such person resides, the department of the attorney general, the  
8 police department of the city or town from which the commitment  
9 originated, and the police department of the city or town where  
10 such person resides.
