AN ACT RELATIVE TO DAYCARE IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any laws or provisions to the contrary, a pilot
2 program shall be established in the city of Lowell to provide
3 training to recipients of A.F.D.C. to become certified daycare
4 providers serving participants of the Employment Training
5 Program, as well as any other low-income family that is eligible
6 for state funded day care services. Concurrently, a day care center
7 shall employ those persons who have successfully completed the
8 training program set forth above. Furthermore, an unspecified
9 number of the participants of this program shall also be trained
10 to provide transportation to and from the day care center using
11 a means of transportation provided by the day care center to
12 facilitate flexible working hours and accessibility.

13 Participation in this program shall be voluntary.
