AN ACT MAKING JOHN F. KENNEDY'S BIRTHDAY A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause eighteenth of section 7 of chapter 4 of the  
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 12 of the acts  
3 of 1978, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word  
4 "May", in line 5, the following words: — May twenty-ninth.

1 SECTION 2. Section 15L of chapter 6 of the General Laws as  
2 added by chapter 8 of the acts of 1968, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out, in line 2, the words, "last Sunday in November", and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following words: — twenty-ninth  
5 day of May.
