AN ACT RELATIVE TO TOWN TREASURERS AND TOWN COLLECTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 41 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the second and third paragraphs.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 41, as so appearing,
2 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "town", in
3 line 32, the following words: — ; provided, however, that the town
4 treasurer shall be appointed for a term of one or three years; and,
5 provided further, that the collector of taxes shall be appointed
6 for a term of one or three years, unless the town votes to authorize
7 its treasurer to act as collectors.
