AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2A of chapter 60A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following sentence: — The Registrar shall
3 have all renewal applications, under the name of the person whose
4 registration has been suspended, imprinted with the words: “not
5 renewable due to unpaid excise taxes”; and he shall not renew any
6 motor vehicle registrations under the name of said person until
7 evidence of payment is presented, together with all interest, costs
8 and release fees.
