AN ACT PROVIDING THAT DISTINCTIVE "VETERAN" AND "PRISONER OF WAR" NUMBER PLATES MAY BE ISSUED FOR USE ON LEASED VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the third sentence the following: — The word
- 4 "owned," as applied to veterans and former prisoners of war, as
- 5 defined herein, shall include leased vehicles. The registrar shall
- 6 make an appropriate notation on the registration certificate of any
- 7 vehicle leased by a veteran or former prisoner of war to whom
- 8 he issues a distinctive number plate as provided herein.
