SENATE No. 1085

By Mr. Cellucci, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1085) of Argeo Paul Cellucci, Lucile P. Hicks, Patricia A. Walrath and Robert A. Durand for legislation to provide that former spouses of persons under the contributory retirement law shall be eligible for nomination as beneficiaries thereunder. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT FORMER SPOUSES OF PERSONS UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION AS BENEFICIARIES THEREUNDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Paragraph 3 of option (c) of subdivision 2 of section twelve,
- 2 as appearing in Chapter 291 of the acts of 1958, is hereby amended
- 3 by adding the following words after the word "spouse" in line
- 4 two: — a former spouse provided that spouse never remarried.
