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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

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AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ABATEMENT OF TAXES CAUSED BY A FIRE IN THE TOWN OF HOLLISTON ON APRIL 8, 1987.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section two A and thirty-  
2 eight of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, the board of  
3 assessors of the town of Holliston may, for the fiscal year  
4 beginning July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven determine  
5 the valuation of property destroyed by the fire of April eighth,  
6 nineteen hundred and eighty-seven, immediately subsequent to  
7 said fire, for the purpose of granting abatements applied for under  
8 section fifty-nine of said chapter fifty-nine.

9 The commissioner of revenue is hereby authorized to reimburse  
10 said town of Holliston for any abatements granted pursuant to  
11 the provisions of this section funds appropriated therefore.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
