AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 258 OF THE ACTS OF 1980 TO FURTHER RESTRICT
ISSUANCE OF WINE AND MALT LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 258 of the Acts of 1980 is hereby amended by striking
2 out from lines 17 through 19 the following language: — The
3 number of licenses for the sale of wines and malts under said
4 section fifteen shall not exceed nine. — and replacing it with the
5 following language: — No further original licenses under said
6 section fifteen for the sale of wines and malts shall be issued until
7 the number of such licenses outstanding thereunder shall have
8 been reduced to zero by cancellation, revocation or the failure of
9 holders of such licenses to apply for renewals, and thereafter, no
10 other such licenses shall be issued.
