2 Development be authorized to sit during the recess of the General  
3 Court to make an investigation and study of House Document  
4 numbered 1718 relative to Rent Control.  
5     Said committee shall report to the General Court the results  
6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk  
9 of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday  
10 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
