AN ACT CREATING A TODDLERS AND PARENTS LEARNING EXPERIENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15, section 54 of the 1986 Official
2 Edition of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended
3 in line four by striking the word "three" and inserting in place
4 thereof the word "four."

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 15 of the 1986 Official Edition of the
2 Massachusetts General Laws is further amended in section fifty-
3 four by inserting in line eight after the words "day care" the
4 following words: — "a toddlers and parents learning experiences
5 program for children ages one to three."
