AN ACT TO REDUCE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE RATES FOR PERSONS WITH LIMITED AND FIXED INCOMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 113B of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appear-
2 ing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the second paragraph: —

4 In fixing and establishing classifications of risks, the com-
5 missioner shall establish rates for insureds who are eligible for
6 financial assistance under the provisions of section six B of chapter
7 one hundred and fifteen, chapter one hundred and eighteen, and
8 chapter one hundred and eighteen A, and title XVI of the Social
9 Security Act, which shall be twenty-five percent less than the rates
10 that would be charged for any policy selected by such insureds.
