AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preserva-
5 tion of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chap-
2 ter two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secre-
3 tary may authorize in the manner set forth under said section
4 thirty-nine, the solemnization of a marriage by Susan Melville in
5 the town of Plympton on July thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
6 eighty-eight between Thomas F. Bowes III of the town of
7 Plympton and Emma Francis of the city of New York, and the
8 state secretary shall issue to said Susan Melville in her capacity
9 as aforesaid a certificate of such authorization.
