AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE GREYHOUND RACING IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 All judges at a greyhound racing meet shall be appointed by
- 2 the Commission. The compensation to be paid to the judges shall
- 3 be determined by the Commission and shall be paid by the
- 4 Association conducting the meet.
