AN ACT EXTENDING THE ADULT FOSTER CARE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (c) of section 2 of chapter 18 of the Massachusetts
2 General Laws is amended by the addition after clause C of the
3 following paragraph: —

4 The department of elder affairs and welfare shall be directed
5 to create a pilot program which will allow relatives to be host
6 families in the Adult Foster Care Program and to provide other
7 home care services for the elderly, and which shall include a sliding
8 fee program in which all qualified elders shall participate.
