AN ACT MAKING A CERTAIN CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN A CERTAIN SPECIAL LAW.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately make a certain  
3 corrective change in a certain special law, therefore it is hereby  
4 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate  
5 preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 191 of the acts of 1982 is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the last sentence.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of September  
2 twentieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
