### AN ACT REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF CIVIL MOTOR VEHICLE INFRAC- TIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. [CONFORMING G.L. C. 90, s. 20 TO G.L. C. 90C,  
2 s. 3.] The fourth paragraph of section 20 of chapter 90 of  
3 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is  
4 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence.

1 SECTION 2. [AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF CIVIL  
2 MOTOR VEHICLE INFRACTION TO INCLUDE ALL NON-  
3 JAILABLE AUTOMOBILE LAW VIOLATIONS.] The first  
4 paragraph of subsection (A) of section 3 of chapter 90C of the  
5 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out,  
6 in line 3, the words "or fine does not exceed one hundred dollars  
7 for the first offense and".

1 SECTION 3. [SAME.] The first paragraph of subsection (B)  
2 of section 3 of chapter 90C of the General Laws, as so appearing,  
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 134 and 135, the words  
4 "or fine for the first offense exceeds one hundred dollars or".
