

SENATE No. 1055

By Mr. Golden, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1055) of William B. Golden and Mary Jeanette Murray (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Hull to enter into a long-term lease with the Nantasket Beach Salt Water Club. Local Affairs. [Local approval received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HULL TO ENTER INTO A LONG-TERM LEASE WITH THE NANTASKET BEACH SALT WATER CLUB.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the Town of Hull is hereby authorized to enter into
3 a long-term lease of up to twenty-five years with the Nantasket
4 Beach Salt Water club for the land presently leased by the Town
5 of Hull to the Nantasket Beach Salt Water Club.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon
2 passage.
