By Mr. Costello, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1109) of Nicholas J. Costello, Thomas G. Palumbo, William B. Golden and Barbara Hildt for legislation to prohibit the diversion of any watershed for water supply purposes. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DIVERSION OF ANY WATERSHED FOR WATER SUPPLY PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 105 of chapter 92 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 line 11, and the word "Quabbin": — the Massachusetts Water
4 Resource Authority shall not divert any water from the
5 Merrimack River, the Connecticut River, Millers River, Sudbury
6 River or the Plymouth Aquifer, for purposes of providing
7 drinking water to its customers.
