AN ACT REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLE PURSUITS BY POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 98A of the General Laws, inserted by chapter 263 of  
2 the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by inserting after the second  
3 sentence the following sentence: — Any police officer engaged in  
4 any pursuit while operating a motor vehicle, however, shall not  
5 exceed the speed limits of the areas through which he is operating  
6 such vehicle unless he has probable cause to believe that the person  
7 or persons he is so pursuing has committed or is committing a  
8 felony.
