AN ACT REGARDING NUMBER PLATES FOR CERTAIN VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 778 of  
3 the acts of 1985, is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
4 word "eye", in line 129, the words: or holds a one hundred percent  
5 service connected disability from wartime service.
