AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALES OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended after  
2 section 22 by inserting the following section: —

3 Section 22A. Every sale at retail of a recreational vehicle by  
4 a vendor doing business in the commonwealth shall be reported  
5 by the vendor to the director on such forms as the director shall  
6 prescribe. The director shall require the reporting of the name and  
7 address of each purchaser and other information as determined  
8 by the director which enable identification of the vehicle sold by  
9 the vendor. Reports of sales shall be maintained by the director  
10 in a manner which will enable any law enforcement officer of the  
11 commonwealth or any of its subdivisions to ascertain the identities  
12 of persons within said officer's jurisdiction who have purchased  
13 recreational vehicles for the purpose of determining if said vehicles  
14 have been registered with the director.

15 For the purposes of this section, the terms "doing business in  
16 the Commonwealth", "sale at retail" and "vendor" shall have the  
17 meanings prescribed in section one of chapter sixty-four H of the  
18 General Laws.
