Harold for legislation to enable certain employees in the Department of Public Works to take promotional exams. Public Service.

AN ACT TO MAKE CERTAIN EMPLOYEES ELIGIBLE TO TAKE PROMOTIONAL EXAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, in order to
2 enable the employees appointed under the provisions of Section
3 2(C)(3) of Chapter 811 of the acts of 1985 to take the next
4 promotional examination for their title, the schedule of
5 permanent offices and positions for the Department of Public
6 Works in effect on January 13, 1986, shall be increased by adding
7 the following permanent positions: —
- 8 4 Supervising Civil Engineers (Civil Engineer VI)
 - 9 12 Associate Civil Engineers (Civil Engineer V)
 - 10 20 Principal Civil Engineers (Civil Engineer IV)
 - 11 36 Senior Civil Engineers (Civil Engineer III)
 - 12 52 Assistant Civil Engineers (Civil Engineer II).
