AN ACT AUTHORIZING PAUL SANTOS TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR REGISTRY INSPECTOR NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law  
2 or rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant  
3 for an appointment as registry inspector, Paul Santos of the town  
4 of Plymouth shall be eligible to take the next open competitive  
5 examination for appointment to the position of registry inspector,  
6 and provided he meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for  
7 certification and appointment to such position.
