AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF MEMBERS OF GROUP 4.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32, Section 3, paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended to include within the definition  
3 of Group 4 employees of the Alcoholic Beverages Control  
4 Commission who hold the position of Special Assistant, Chief  
5 Special Assistant or Supervising Special Assistant, employees of  
6 the Bureau of Special Investigations of the Executive Office of  
7 Administration and Finance who hold the position of Senior  
8 Special Investigator, Special Investigator or Supervising Special  
9 Investigator, employees of the Department of Public Utilities who  
10 hold the position of Commercial Motor Vehicle Investigator or  
11 Supervising Investigator of Commercial Motor Vehicles.
