

SENATE No. 1336

By Ms. Melconian, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1336) of Linda J. Melconian for legislation relative to payment of interest on the accounts of teachers and school administrators with the public school system who are employed for less than five years. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE ACCOUNTS OF TEACHERS AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS WITH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM WHO ARE EMPLOYED FOR LESS THAN FIVE YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11(1)(A) of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding in line 9 after the words "For any such member" the
4 following language:

5 "except provided that if such member is a public school teacher
6 or a public school administrator such members shall receive the
7 rate of regular interest at twenty-five percent of the rate of regular
8 interest otherwise payable for purposes of calculating total
9 deductions:".

The Secretary is hereby authorized to employ such persons as he may deem necessary for the efficient conduct of the business of the Senate, and to fix their salaries, not exceeding the rates fixed by law for similar positions in the Executive Department.

The Commission of Investigation

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six

SECTION 1. The Commission of Investigation shall be composed of five members, to be appointed by the Senate, and shall have the same powers and duties as are conferred upon the Commission of Investigation created by the Senate in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

SECTION 2. The Commission of Investigation shall have the same powers and duties as are conferred upon the Commission of Investigation created by the Senate in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

- 3. Section 11(A) of Chapter 53 of the District Code, as amended in the 1926 District Code, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the words "and such section" the following language:
- 4. "except provided that if such member is a public school teacher or a public school administrator such member shall receive the rate of regular pay for the position of teacher or administrator as such member is entitled to receive for the purpose of computing and distributing the same."
