AN ACT REGULATING FUNERAL EXPENSES IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the second  
2 sentence of the first paragraph of section one hundred G  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
3 chapter forty-one of the General Laws, or of any other general  
4 or special law to the contrary, the provisions of said section one  
5 hundred G  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said chapter forty-one shall be effective in the  
6 city of Boston as of October twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and  
7 eighty-seven.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
