AN ACT PROCLAIMING THE FIRST SUNDAY IN OCTOBER AS INDEPENDENT LIVING CENTER DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after second 15GGG, inserted by chapter 174 of the acts of 1988,
3 the following section: —

4 Section 15HHH. The governor shall annually issue a
5 proclamation setting apart the first Sunday of October as
6 Independent Living Center Day recommending that said day be
7 observed by the people in an appropriate manner.
