AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN COSTS INCURRED IN THE OPERATION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of Section 21 of Chapter 161A of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "company" in line 5, the words: — except that such action for
4 personal injuries or death shall be limited to one hundred
5 thousand dollars, and further, that the Authority shall not be
6 liable for interest prior to judgment or for punitive damages.
