AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BENEFITS FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES AND SURVIVING MINOR CHILDREN OF CORRECTION OFFICERS KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause forty-two of section 5 of chapter 59 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended in line 1039 by adding the words "correction officer"
4 after the words police officer each time it appears.

1 SECTION 2. Clause forty-three of section 5 of chapter 59 of
2 the General Laws as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended in lines 1045 and 1046 by adding the words
4 "correction officer" after the words police officer each time it
5 appears.
