SENATE, January 5, 1989.

1    *Ordered*, That the Rules of the Senate be amended by adding  
2 after Rule 59, the following: —  
3                    Television and Transcription  
4    59A. All formal sessions of the Senate shall be televised and  
5 transcribed in such manner as approved by the Committee on  
6 Rules. The televising and transcription of the Senate shall begin  
7 with the first formal session held for consideration of the fiscal  
8 year 1990 budget and continue until the first Wednesday in  
9 November when the Senate shall determine by recorded vote  
10 whether or not to continue to permit the televising of the formal  
11 sessions of the Senate.
