1 *Ordered*, That the Rules of the Senate be amended by inserting  
2 after Rule 59 the following new rule: —

3 Rule 59A. Effective January 3, 1990, all formal sessions of the  
4 Senate shall be open to commercial and public radio transmission.  
5 The manner and conditions of such transmission shall be  
6 established by the President. In addition, tapes of formal and  
7 informal sessions of the Senate shall be recorded by the Senate  
8 and made available for public inspection. This rule shall not be  
9 suspended unless by unanimous consent of the members present.
